Stylish Christmas Centerpieces for you to make and enjoy!

## Materials List for Xmas Wreath Centerpiece

- fresh or storebought pine wreath
- hobby decorations - glitter, bows, ribbons
- large decorative bow

Follow these simple steps to make your wreath centerpiece:

- Place the wreath securely on a flat surface.
- Arrange all of your decorative materials out in an orderly fashion.
- Gather your kids for a fun filled time.
- Place decorative materials of ribbons, glitter, pine nuts, corn and other holiday festive decorations on the wreath.
- Attach any small ornaments you may want to include.

## Special Holiday tips

- Use candle sconces to make an attractive flare to the wreath
- Try to stay away from velcro- use wire based products
- honey dip and bake pine cones with glued on decorations
- Use a family picture in the center of the wreath.
- Create a structure of many wreaths arranged together to form one large one!
